

Installing eMac Airport Card

Tools used in this guide

• Phillips #2 Screwdriver (1)

Installing a AirPort Card

This machine uses the:

Apple 630-2883 Original APPLE-MAC Airport 802.11B Wireless Card from the 700 MHz machine through the eMac (ATI Graphics). After that it uses the Apple M8881LL/A AirPort Extreme Card





Step 1 - Airport Card

- Installation of the AirPort Card on this machine is very easy.
- The AirPort slot is located just above the Optical Drive in the front of the unit. It is covered by a small plastic panel.
- To access it, press the eject arrow located on the upper right corner of your keyboard. Once it's open hold it gently and shut down the machine.
- Remove the two Phillips screws located to the right and left sides of the panel.
- The Airport cable is snapped into place on the back of the panel. Gently remove the panel from it.
- Slide the Airport card into the slot till you fell it seat.
- Attach the cable.
- Replace the Panel and restart the machine.





Step 2

- To set the Airport up go under the Apple in the upper left hand corner to System Preferences - Network. The Airport option should be on the left hand window. Select it.
- It should set up on its own. If not hit the Assist Me box on the bottom of the page.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
